First off, thank you for your interest in Bay Lights Charters! We are excited that you are considering our gorgeous 72-foot Tall Ship Schooner to host your private event on the water!

We would LOVE to take you all out sailing and together create your vision.

Date- Let us know the date you want to sail and we can compare calendars. We work on a first come first served basis so availability can change. Please note, No date or time is secure until a deposit is made.

Timing- We typically sail from: 11-2 pm or 3-6 pm
** custom time slots are also available

About the Yacht- Our historic-style yacht is designed like no other on the bay with your absolute comfort in mind. She boasts wide decks topside and a speakeasy-like open and spacious “living room” below the decks with two restrooms. This yacht is complete with a full bar, lounging couches, and a long mahogany table that is a great place to get out of the elements and to enjoy each other in a relaxed and cozy environment.

Participation- Our Experienced Captain and Crew will recruit anyone wanting to help hoist the sails. Participation is always encouraged but voluntary. The whole team will share their knowledge of San Francisco’s enchanting history and the many beautiful sights along the waterfront in an effort to enhance the experience for all aboard.

Catering- Together we can customize the food and beverage options to fit your budget and desires. Catering is available or you are welcome to bring your own food for a \$150 set up fee that includes set up breakdown, plates napkins and utensils. Our caterers offer many options and will work with your vision and budget to include local farm to market options all while making sure to have vegetarian/vegan selections or choices.

Bar- We are fully licensed by the state of California. We have Beer, Wine, and Cocktails available.
**No outside alcoholic beverages are allowed. The beverage service is based on the type of service.
Prices range: \$7 - \$14- We take Visa, MasterCard, Amex, PayPal, Venmo- no cash, sorry!

We are a cashless vessel.

Hosted (open) bar is \$40 per person.

Tally Bar- a tab is run for drinks consumed while onboard and the bar total is settled before leaving the boat. Drink tickets can be pre purchased at \$11 each. These are good for beer, wine, cocktails, and hard seltzers. This is a good way to buy the first round for your guests.

The bar opens as soon as we pull off the docks and the last call is 30 minutes before returning.

Docking Locations- You are welcome to meet the boat in several different locations. We are required to use a commercial dock and each location charges a different fee to use their docks:

Marina Village in Alameda docking included in packages

San Francisco at Pier 40 by the Giants Stadium the docking is included in the packages

Marina Bay in Richmond for a docking fee of \$650

Feel free to ask us about other locations- depending on tides and ferry schedules some other locations can be used and fees vary - like Sausalito or Angel Island



Gratuity- above total does not include gratuity for the Captain and crew. Most people tip 15-20% of the charter rate, like a restaurant

How to secure the date- When you are ready to secure your preferred date and time with a deposit let us know and we will send over a payable invoice. The date and time is not secure until the deposit is paid. The full balance is due when we confirm the final details such as food and beverage, no later than 7 days before your event.

Our experienced Captain and Crew are here to accommodate your vision, our goal is to meet and exceed your expectations for fast and friendly service.

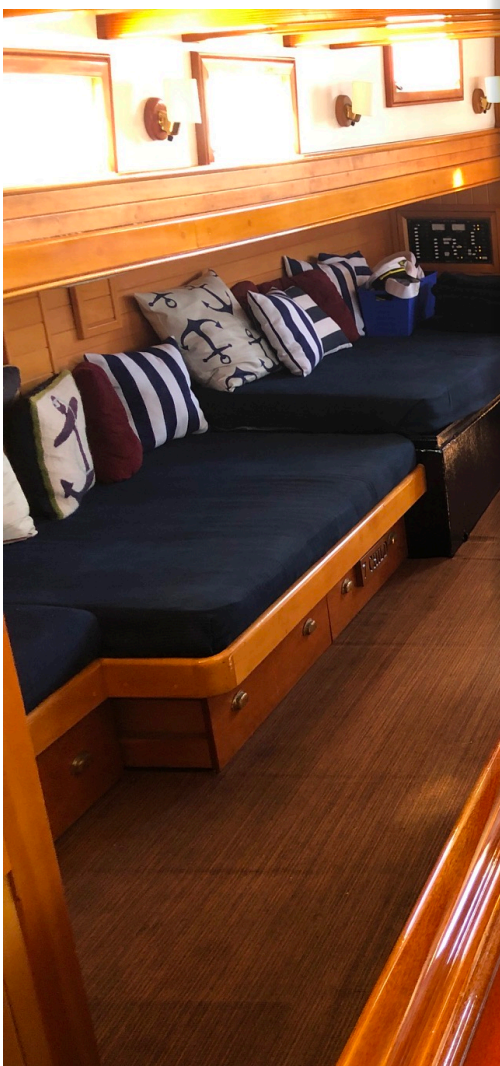

THE YACHT GAS LIGHT

'Gas Light'

Scow Schooner sailing replica design from 1876. Launched in 2000.

Gas Light is a meticulously maintained, steel hulled Vessel. She holds a current Coast Guard certification for up to 49 passengers and 5 crew members. She is presently used by her owners as a full time charter yacht, in San Francisco, California. Gas Light offers a one-of-a-kind experience. She is a historic schooner, 72 feet in length that was launched in 2000. Gas Light is designed specifically for passenger comfort and safety. She provides a warm, comfortable, and stable ride for all. Full of historic charm yet designed with modern amenities, she is a true gem on the water. Our vessel has open, wide decks for enjoying the famous San Francisco Bay views under sail. Below decks, guests may enjoy beverages from a full licensed bar with a catered meal. A large centerline table for entertaining and lounge seating on either side of the spacious main salon provides areas to mingle and warm up with beautifully finished hard woods. Guests have the ability to comfortably visit below decks before 'going topsides' onto her spacious decks to enjoy the sun, wind, and sea.

Historic Scow Schooners from Gold Rush Era

Bay Lights Charters Inc. was founded in 2017 when the vessel "Gas Light" was purchased from her original builder and operator, Billy Martinelli. Mr. Martinelli had a vision in the early 1990's of designing, building and putting into passenger service a modern replica of a historic vessel that worked the San Francisco Bay waters she is currently sailing today. Gas Light was designed using a "scow schooner" concept for the hull and the rig.

This design was the standard of the day before highways, bridges and railroads were available. Her hull and deck are fabricated of steel, yet her masts are traditional solid Douglas Fir, hand picked from Mendocino County in California. This design of schooner was the 18-wheeler of the day, transporting thousands of tons of goods throughout San Francisco Bay and its Delta in the late 1800's. Gas Light was launched in 2000 and soon began passenger charter day sails after receiving her U.S. Coast Guard Certificate of Inspection for 49 passengers and 5 crew.

Instead of a cargo hold, Gas Light was built with a beautiful, warm open interior trimmed with solid red and yellow cedar and a 15 foot long, mahogany center table. The vessel and its owners have meticulously maintained Gas Light to provide an unforgettable first-class experience for their guests. Because of her history as a living replica, sailing on Gas Light is like stepping back in time 150 years to a very different world centered around the California gold rush.

The unique design of Gas Light's hull creates a very stable and comfortable ride on the Bay. Gas Light's owners, captains and crew make sure its guests have an experience that enhances the rich local history while providing a brag-worthy excursion along the San Francisco waterfront.
